

Terms & Conditions

- The MAKE IT HAPPEN Challenge ("Challenge") details at <https://winn-hub.com/make-it-happen/> form part of these terms and conditions.
- The promoter is [Worcestershire County Council of County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester WR5 2NP (the "Promoter")].
- The Challenge is only open to residents of, and businesses based in, the county of Worcestershire, UK. Winners will need to be able to provide proof of identification and proof of address in the county of Worcestershire, UK.
- If you are under the age of 18, you must obtain written parental or guardian consent to enter and claim your prize. The Promoter may ask the winner to provide proof of age.
- Use of a false name or address will result in disqualification.
- By submitting an application form and entering the Challenge you:
 - agree to be bound by these terms and conditions;
 - agree that any personal information provided by you with the Challenge entry may be held and used only by the Promoter or its agents and suppliers to administer the Challenge.
 - confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim any prize you may win; and
 - warrant that all information submitted by you is true, current and complete to the best of your knowledge.
- The contact details you provide with your Challenge entry will be used to notify you of any prizes so please make sure they are correct.
- The Challenge is free to enter and no purchase is necessary.
- All entries must be made directly by the person (being a director or owner, where the entrant is a business) entering the Challenge.
- No responsibility can be accepted for entries lost, delayed or corrupted, or due to computer error in transit.

- The application judging criteria for entry is as follows:
 - Description of the project: Does the applicant give an adequate description of the project?
 - Project details: Is the product/process sufficiently novel and AWESOME?

- Project stages: Has the project stage been identified with clear next steps demonstrated?
 - Prize considerations: Is the requirement for the prize, including cash and sponsor packages adequately explained?
